

CRIHM Open Access Publication Reimbursement Scheme

Call for Applications – Publication Fee Reimbursement

The Cancer Research and Innovation Hub Malta (CRIHM) is pleased to announce a new scheme to support the dissemination of cancer-related research through open access publishing. The initiative aims to enhance visibility, promote collaboration, and ensure public access to high-quality research outputs.

Key Details

- Maximum Reimbursement: €2,000 per publication
- Total Budget: €40,000 (first-come, first-served basis)
- Eligible Publications:
 - Must be cancer-related
 - Published in a journal with an Impact Factor ≥ 2
 - Must be already accepted for publication (proof required)
- Eligibility:
 - Corresponding author must be affiliated with a Maltese institution
 - The publication must not have received other funding for the open-access fee
 - Applicants must submit a signed declaration confirming no double funding

Acknowledgment Requirement

If reimbursed, authors are kindly requested to acknowledge, if possible, CRIHM's support in the publication using the following statement:

"This publication was supported by the Cancer Research and Innovation Hub Malta (CRIHM) under its Open Access Publication Reimbursement Scheme."

Visibility

Accepted and supported publications will be listed on the CRIHM website to further increase their impact and visibility within the national and international research community.

Application Process

Applicants must provide:

- A completed application form
- Proof of acceptance of the article
- Invoice and payment receipt (or publisher quote)
- Declaration of no double funding
- Journal metrics confirming that it is ≥ 2

Applications will be processed on a rolling basis until funds are exhausted.
